This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to transfer the petitioner on medical ground to Delhi or any place where the Tertiary Hospital with Neuro Surgical Neurology and Maxillofacial Surgical facilities are available as per the Medical Certificate by Army Hospital (R&R) Delhi Cantt. (Annexure P-4).
