This is the first petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.57 dated 03.04.2019, registered under Sections 22 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Model Town, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the pleas which were raised and are available to him, before the trial Court.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

Needless to say that the pleas raised by the petitioner before the trial Court would be considered independently on merits without being influenced by the present order passed.
