Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.67 dated 30.03.2022, registered for offences under Sections 323, 354, 447, 511, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3 (2) (v) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (for short “the SC&ST Act”), at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, Annexure P-1.
