Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0031 dated 15.04.2022, under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Naya Gaon, District SAS Nagar.

Vide order dated 18.05.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 18.05.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dilbagh Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 18.05.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
