The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.11 dated 15.4.2022 registered under Sections 376, 120-B IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

By virtue of the order dated 19.5.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and submitted that they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 19.5.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
