Petitioner Jasmeet Kaur has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to challenge the order dated 27.08.2011 (Annexure P-2) passed by revisional Court, whereby the decision dated 08.07.2009 (Annexure P-1) passed by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Tohana, dismissing her claim to seek maintenance under Section 125 Cr.P.C., was upheld.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the matrimonial dispute between the parties has been amicably settled and they decided to sever the matrimonial tie.
