Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner is entitled for the grant of retiral benefit, keeping in view the order passed by a Division Bench of this Court in **CWP-19641-2009** titled as **R.K. Aggarwal and others vs. State of Haryana and others** decided on 21.12.2012 but, the petitioner has not been granted the benefit of the same by the respondents without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of filing a representation dated 03.03.2022 (Annexure P/10), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 03.03.2022 (Annexure P/10) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his representation, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 03.03.2022 (Annexure P/10) by passing a speaking order within a period of 08 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to him within a period of next 04 weeks.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
