Learned counsel for the appellant submits that as per the compromise dated 09.12.2019 (Annexure A-1), the appellant has executed the sale deed in favour of the respondent-wife Mandeep Kaur and minor son Tanveer Singh and the respondent has given instructions to her counsel to withdraw both the cases pending before the Trial Court, one under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and second under Section 125 of the Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the respondent has admitted the above-said facts and submits that both the cases will be withdrawn within 10 days.

The parties are present in person in Court and they are not disputing the compromise (Annexure A-1) arrived at between them.

Statements of both the parties have also been recorded. Self attested copies of Aadhar Cards of both the parties are taken on record.

In the present case the parties have amicably resolved their dispute. As per compromise dated 09.12.2019 (Annexure A-1) the appellant has executed sale deed of house of 05 marlas situated in khasra No.71//18 in favour of respondent-wife Mandeep Kaur (90% share) and minor son Tanveer Singh (10% share) in lieu of the full and final settlement. The respondent is ready to withdraw both the cases registered against the appellant. Since all the conditions of the compromise dated 09.12.2019 (Annexure A-1) have been complied with, the present appeal is allowed the impugned order is set aside and the parties are granted divorce under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act. Decree sheet be drawn accordingly.

Since sale deed has been executed in favour of respondent Mandeep Kaur and minor son Tanveer Singh, a direction is further issued to the Revenue Authorities to enter the mutation in favour of Mandeep Kaur and minor son Tanveer Singh.
