1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 02.09.2021, in CWP-17119-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 02.09.2021, reveals that CWP-17119-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 02.01.2021, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within four months, from the date of order.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has filed copy of order dated 30.05.2022, that the petitioner could not be considered for grant of senior higher scale and promotion by giving him seniority from 1985 in view of Punjab Government instructions dated 26.10.1995 and Rule 4.23 of the Punjab Civil Services Rules Volume-2, as per which adhoc service is to be counted only for the purpose of pensionary benefits. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner,

who on perusal thereof states in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to challenge order dated 30.05.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
