Instant petition has been filed under Section 439(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short “the Code”) read with Section 482 of the Code seeking setting aside impugned orders dated 03.02.2020, Annexure P-4 and 12.02.2020, Annexure P-5, passed by the Trial Court in BA No.370 of 2020, whereby respondents No.2 and 3 were granted interim and absolute anticipatory bail in case FIR No.143 dated 27.11.2019, registered for offences under Sections 498-A, 313 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3 of Scheduled Castes and Schedules Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station Women, Sector 51, Gurugram, Annexure P-2.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the settlement between the parties, he does not press the petition. He seeks liberty to revive the petition in case the compromise fails.

Dismissed as not pressed with liberty as sought.
