Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, the petitioner has a stage carriage permit for operating a bus on Gurdaspur to Amritsar via Kalanour, Dera Baba Nanak route but the petitioner is facing difficulty and harassment as, the regular time table has not been fixed for the smooth operation of the buses. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents are liable to be directed to frame the appropriate time table for the operation of the buses so that the operators do not face any harassment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by serving upon them a legal notice dated 26.04.2022 (Annexure P-7), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Deepali Puri Sandhu, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 26.04.2022 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by it in the legal notice dated 26.04.2022 (Annexure P-7), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 26.04.2022 (Annexure P-7) within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.
