Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned action of respondent No.3, whereby an objection was raised qua the eligibility of the petitioner for appointment to the post of ETT Teacher in pursuance of advertisement dated 30.07.2021 (P-9).

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the representation dated 09.02.2022 (P-12) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 09.02.2022 (P-12) by passing speaking order as per law within two weeks from today positively.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
