Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.158 dated 22.07.2018, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 406, 420, 506 IPC.

Vide order dated 31.05.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner with a direction to join the investigation and vide order dated 06.09.2022 he was again directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she has tried to contact with the petitioner, but he could not be contacted, therefore, she has no instructions, as to whether the petitioner has joined the investigation or not.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Satish, submits that despite availing two opportunities, the petitioner has not joined the investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner way back on 31.05.2022, but even after availing two opportunities, the petitioner has not joined the investigation, thus, the conduct of the petitioner shows disrespect to the orders passed by this Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
