The matter was brought before the Financial Commissioner, Revenue arising out of the partition proceedings. He remanded the case to the Assistant Collector for a fresh decision and remitted the original record to the said authority. Allegedly, the original record has not been received by the Assistant Collector and thus, a representation dated 05.04.2022 has been made before the Deputy Commissioner-respondent No.2 to get the record traced, however, the record is still not traceable. Thus, the present writ petition has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to take action upon the aforementioned representation.

Being a purely administrative issue, the High Court would not exercise jurisdiction vested under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for resolution of the matter. Thus, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to approach the concerned administrative authority.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty.
