This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to official respondents to initiate disciplinary action against official respondents No.4 and 5 with a further prayer to look into the matter and to take appropriate legal action against the private respondents and for constituting SIT for just and fair investigation of the matter.

A status report dated 06.06.2022 was filed by way of affidavit of Avtar Singh PPS, DSP (Rural) Abohar, District Fazilka on behalf of State. Relevant paragraph No.4 of status report is as under:-

“That no illegality or impropriety has been committed by the police in the present matter. The police has acted in the present matter properly. False allegations have been leveled against the police. The present petition is based on false facts. As such, no cause of action has accrued to the petitioner to file the present petition.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has gone through the above mentioned status report and is satisfied with the action taken by the Police. He has instructions from his client to state that the same has been rendered infructuous on an additional ground that in the bail application the accused have deposited Rs.2 lakhs in view of the direction of this Court.

Keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.
