Petition was filed in the year 2002, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant the petitioner minimum of the pay-scale of the post of Counter Clerk i.e. 3,050-4,350/- w.e.f. the date of appointment with all consequential relief.

2. Matter was though remanded back by the Supreme Court for fresh adjudication, however, on being asked to argue, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no instructions. He had earlier also pleaded the same, owing thereof fresh notice was issued to the petitioner, which too has been served. Despite that neither any arrangement has been made by the petitioner to substitute the learned counsel appearing nor have any instructions been given to him.

3. It seems that by sheer effluxion of time and pendency of the writ petition for more than 20 years before this Court, either it has been rendered

infructuous or even otherwise the petitioner seems to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

4. In view of the aforesaid, no grounds are made out to interfere.

5. Dismissed.
