[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/6 dated 09.11.2021 in CWP No.22170 of 2021 in case titled as Balbir Kaur vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/6 reveals that CWP No.22170 of 2021 was disposed of on the statement of learned State counsel that amount as per the award passed by the Land Acquisition Collector under Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 would be released to the petitioner within one month.

[3] Today, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in terms of order, Annexure P/6 dated 09.11.2021, needful has been done and payment as per entitlement has been released to the petitioner as per the award passed by the Land Acquisition Collector under Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
