Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the petitioner was senior to respondent No.4 namely, Sonu Yadav in the cadre of JBT and was entitled for promotion in preference to respondent No.4 but, the respondent No.4 was promoted on 24.09.2010 whereas, the case of the petitioner for promotion was not considered by the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner was ultimately promoted as TGT (Science) with effect from 17.07.2018 and the only grievance which survives is that the petitioner be promoted as TGT (Science) with effect from the date, respondent No.4 was promoted to the said post along with consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of serving a legal notice dated 21.09.2021 (Annexure P/6) upon them, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be

satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said legal Notice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Kumar Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 21.09.2021 (Annexure P/6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his legal notice, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 21.09.2021 (Annexure P/6) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
