Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider representation dated 21.06.2021 (Annexure P-29) of the petitioner in a fair and transparent manner as adopted in all other similar examinations with regard to the impugned decision *qua* measurement of height of the petitioner and resultant wrongful rejection of the petitioner for the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police.

2. It transpires that during pendency of the writ proceedings, petitioner was summoned by the competent authority for re-measurement of his height and subsequent thereto having been found to have met the minimum physical parameters, he was allowed the benefit thereof, as has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner. He further submits that per his instructions, in fact, petitioner has also been told that appointment letter is likely to be issued in due course.

3. Being so, nothing survives for adjudication before this Court. Writ petition is disposed of with the expectation that since the petitioner continues to be out of job while his counter-parts were already appointed, needed exercise *qua* him be done within a period of 30 days from today. Needless to say, petitioner shall not be entitled to any monetary benefits in case, till date of actual appointment, if any favourable order is passed. However, he shall be allowed the notional benefits as given to his counterparts.

4. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
