Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 48 dated 17.03.2021, under Sections 307, 323 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Munak, District Karnal.

Learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner is the nephew of the complainant and the FIR is outcome of a civil dispute between them. The injuries, which were allegedly caused in the occurrence, are simple in nature and on the non-vital parts of the body of the complainant. He also contends that the matter is being compromised.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that efforts are on to draw the terms of the settlement.

This Court, by the order dated 30.11.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation

and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sandeep Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 30.11.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
