Complaining wilful disobedience of the order dated 09.05.2019 passed in CWP-27562-2017, the petitioner has filed the present contempt petition. The operative part of the order dated 09.05.2019 reads as under:-

*“The petitioner is entitled for payment of interest @ 9 % per annum from the date it became due i.e. , 01.02.2017 till the said amount was released i.e. 15.11.2017. Let the amount of interest be calculated by the respondents for which the petitioner is entitled for , within a period of two months from the receipt of copy of this order and the amount so calculated shall be released to the petitioner, within a period within a period of one month thereafter.*

*The writ petition is allowed in above terms .”*

Learned State counsel has stated that the amount of interest, as directed, has already been released to the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid, no further order is required to be passed.
