Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners.

2. Petition was admitted for hearing on 29.10.2002.

3. When taken up for final adjudication, after around 20 years, learned counsel is unable to assist the Court for lack of instructions.

4. Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that services of the petitioner have been regularized and tenders an office order dated 17.02.2012, which is taken on record. In view of the aforesaid, the claim of the petitioners is rendered infructuous to that extent.

6. Writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to take up their cause with the department in case they have any grievance qua the effective date of their regularization, which is not the subject matter before this Court.

7. Disposed of with aforesaid liberty.
