[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 01.02.2022 in CWP No.668 of 2022 in case titled as Suman Devi vs State of Haryana and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.668 of 2022 was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 therein to decide legal notice dated 21.01.2021 and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to any pecuniary benefits, to release the same to the petitioner within three months thereafter.

[3] Learned Addl. A.G. has produced copy of order dated 18.04.2022 passed by the General Manager, Haryana Roadways Chandigarh holding the petitioner entitled to certain benefits. The same

is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner who states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 18.04.2022 to the extent the same denies benefits as claimed by way appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
