Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to provide her protection from respondent No.4.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was married to respondent No.4 in the year 2001 and three children were born out of the wedlock. He submits that the petitioner has been turned out of the matrimonial home and respondent No.4 has been troubling and tormenting her even though, she is staying separately. He submits that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 17.05.2022, Annexure P-1, to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana, but the same is not being attended to. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the same.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on their behalf.

Having heard counsel for the parties and without examining the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine the representation, Annexure P-1 and take suitable action thereon, as warranted in accordance with law.

Copy of this order as well as representation, Annexure P-1, be sent to respondent No.2 in order to enable him to proceed expeditiously.
