HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners were appointed in the reserved handicap category, which is clear from the appointment order of the petitioners, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-1 with this petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the benefit which has been claimed by them has already been allowed by the Division Bench of this Court to the similarly situated employees while passing order in CWP No.18164 of 1999, decided on 18.10.2001, hence, the petitioners be also granted the same benefit as extended to the petitioners in CWP No.18164 of 1999.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that though the present petition was admitted but no reply has been filed so far qua the claim of the petitioners. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that the claim of the petitioners will be considered for regularization of their services keeping in view the order passed by the Division Bench and appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of eight weeks and in case, it is found that the petitioners in the present petition and the petitioners in CWP No.18164 of 1999 decided on 18.10.2001, were on the same footings, appropriate relief as extended to the petitioners in CWP No.18164 of 1999 will also be extended to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the above statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.

As the main case has been disposed of, application i.e. CM-19441-CWP-2002 also stands disposed of.
