ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Aggrieved by the order dated 30.08.2018 (P-9), passed by the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Bassi Pathana, the petitioner claiming to be beneficiary, has come up before this Court.

After hearing counsel for the parties for considerable time, this Court does not find any illegality in the aforesaid order dated 30.08.2018 except that, interest of parties would be better met in case the auction amount instead of being deposited in the government treasury is used in making the fixed deposit in any public sector bank in the name of Sub Divisional Magistrate, Bassi Pathana with automatic renewable clause.

It shall be permissible for the parties to apply for their share or its release as per the fact situation and the concerned Sub Divisional Magistrate shall be fully entitled to order such release in the law and spirit of the order dated 30.08.2018 by him and any subsequent orders/decrees.

Petition is disposed of with the aforesaid observations.
