AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (ORAL)

This is a petition seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 60, dated 28.5.2020, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Dehlon, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

One of the ground for seeking bail is that there is no progress in the trial as none of the prosecution witness has been examined.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that there are total thirteen prosecution witnesses and all are police officials. He submits that instructions issued by DGP Punjab would be strictly implemented and it would be ensured that the prosecution evidence is concluded within six months from the date fixed. Necessary action if so required against the non-cooperating officials would be taken.

In view of above statement, the petition is disposed of at this stage.

There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the Court concerned for accommodating the date for examining the prosecution witnesses, the same would be considered in accordance with law.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
