The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.24 dated 28.4.2022 registered under Sections 313, 323, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC at Woman Police Station, Manesar, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

By virtue of the order dated 20.5.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 20.5.2022 petitioner has joined investigation and fully cooperated and thus the interim order may kindly be made absolute. He further submits that petitioner has also paid the litigation expenses of Rs.25,000/- as directed by this court, however, the mediation proceedings remained unsuccessful.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by counsel for petitioner. He submits that mediation proceedings failed because of the adamant attitude of the petitioner. He also

submits that recovery of dowry articles still remains to be effected.

Learned State counsel on instructions from LASI Jyoti has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 20.5.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
