This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing the order dated 24.2.2020 (Annexure P-1), whereby the petitioner was ordered to be transferred against the circular issued by the respondent department. It is also prayed that during the pendency of the present petition the petitioner be not transferred.

Counsel for the respondent submits that vide order dated 24.4.2021, the petitioner has since been dismissed from service by way of departmental action; on account of continuous absence without permission. Hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
