The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No. 149 dated 18.2.2020, under Section 174-A IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula.

After arguing for some time and realising that the present petition is not maintainable in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in **Manish Jain v. Haryana State Pollution Control Board, 2021(1) AICLR 416**, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender within fifteen days from today and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

Dismissed as not pressed. In case the petitioner surrenders within fifteen days from today and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application within one day and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
