ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of the petitioner for taking her on the rolls of Municipal Corporation has been erroneously declined by the impugned order dated 12.04.2022 (Annexure P-10), wherein it has been held that there is no entry in her EPF statement with regard to payment of salary to her for the month of November, 2018. He, however, submits that the salary of two months including November and December, 2018 was paid in January, 2019, which is duly reflected in the Bank statement (Annexure P-1) at page 19 wherein a sum of Rs.16,505/- was credited in the account of the petitioner on 16.01.2019.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Heard.

A perusal of the impugned order indicates that the case of the petitioner has been rejected on the ground that the salary of November, 2018 was not paid to her, meaning thereby, that she was not continuously working with the respondents. A perusal of the bank statement of the petitioner (Annexure P-1) indicates that salary of a sum of Rs.16,505/- was paid. It is, thus, apparent that there is a factual error in the impugned order which, therefore, deserves to be set aside.

Consequently, the present petition is allowed and the impugned order dated 12.04.2022 (Annexure P-10) is set aside. The respondents would be at liberty to pass a fresh order after due verification of the factual backdrop and affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. Needful shall be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
