Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that though the petitioner has already retired from service of respondents on 31.01.2020 but the retiral benefits admissible to the petitioner at the time of retirement are not being released to him and therefore, appropriate direction be issued to respondent No.3 to release the same along with interest. Learned counsel further submits that for claiming the said benefits, the petitioner has already served upon the respondents a legal notice dated 10.06.2020 (Annexure P-5) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 10.06.2020 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 10.06.2020 (Annexure P-5), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 15.02.2022 (Annexure P-3) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
