Main Case

1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 14.03.2019, in CWP-7598-2017 in case titled as Naveen Kumar vs. Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, Chandigarh and others.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-7598-2017 was allowed and orders rejecting the candidature of the petitioner on the ground of mis-match of hand writing/signatures with various documents were quashed and the respondents were directed to complete all formalities for appointment of the petitioner and to issue him appointment letter as per the result declared by them within four weeks

from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 14.03.2019 in CWP-7598-2017, the petitioner has been issued appointment letter and has been allowed to join service, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
