ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent-Commission to recommend the name of the petitioner on the post of Conductor, claiming to have secured 171 marks in the written examination, since in the final result, after adding the marks of the interview, the cut off marks have been shown as 171.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to an earlier order dated 29.04.2019 passed by this court, result of the petitioner has been received and he has secured an aggregate of 161 marks (150 marks in the written examination + 11 marks in interview). The cut off marks for the waiting list of General Category is 170 marks and the last selected candidate has secured 171 marks. Petitioner was under wrong impression that he had secured 171 marks in the written examination.

3. In the premise, it seems that being unaware of his actual result, the petitioner was misled into filing the instant petition premised on an understanding that he has obtained 171 marks in the written examination. However, he has actually scored 161 aggregate marks, as aforesaid.
4. The result of the petitioner is not under challenge before this Court. Being so, no further grounds to interfere are made out.
5. Dismissed.
