Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Code of the Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of direction to official respondents No.1 to 3 to take action on the complaint dated 11.05.2022, Annexure P-5 submitted by the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had a run-away marriage with Satish Kumar and had approached this Court seeking protection. He submits that vide order dated 28.11.2014, Annexure P-2, this Court directed the respondents to examine the representation and provide necessary protection, if required. She submits that thereafter respondents No.4 to 6, who are related to her husband, have been harassing and humiliating her. An application dated 11.05.2022, Annexure P-5, has been submitted by her with the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, respondent No.2, which is not been

acted upon. She submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the same.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on their behalf.

Having considered the matter, but without examining the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine the application, Annexure P-5, and take suitable action thereon, as warranted in accordance with law.
