The petitioners have sought a direction to the respondents to release the arrears of benefit of 4, 9 and 14 years under the Assured Career Progression Scheme.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of the Joint Secretary, Department of Local Government, Punjab, on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 wherein it has been stated that the entire arrears have been paid to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that although the respondents have made the payment but the petitioners would be entitled to interest thereon.

Heard.

The petitioners had sent legal notice claiming arrears on 31.08.2021 and they have preferred this petition during the same year. Therefore, I do not find that the petitioners are entitled to any interest.

In view of the above, this petition has been rendered infructuous and stands disposed of accordingly.
