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**RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)**

This petition has been filed impugning the order dated 17.07.2017 whereby the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate (NRI Court), Jalandhar has dismissed the application filed by petitioner for dismissal of execution application.

It is reiterated by learned counsel for the respondent as was done on 7<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 that the matter is amicably settled and out of Rs.50,00,000/- full and final settled amount, Rs.25,00,000/- has already been given to the respondent whereas, remaining Rs.25,00,000/- would be given at the time of recording of the second motion statement. From the perusal of the record, it is apparent that nobody is appearing for the petitioner from the last three dates. The position remains same as on date.

In the facts and circumstances, this Court is convinced that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present case.

Petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
