ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed for grant of the parole of the petitioner on account of death of his mother on 24.01.2022. Counsel for the petitioner seeks eight weeks parole on medical ground.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended and satisfied in case, he may be permitted to file fresh application for parole giving detailed reasons for returning late after availing previous parole and the concerned authority be directed consider the same afresh. He further submits that due to the illness of his son, the petitioner had surrendered late and has medical evidence to corroborate his submission.

Given above, the present petition is disposed of with the liberty to the petitioner to file fresh application for parole before the concerned authority on medical grounds. The concerned authority shall verify the authenticity of the medical record in case it is found to be true, then the application for parole shall be considered sympathetically and be decided within 10 working days from its receipt. In case of rejection of application, order shall be supported by valid reasons.

Liberty reserved to the petitioner to come to this Court again in case need so arises in future.
