The present petition has been filed praying for quashing of FIR No.65 dated 3.6.2019 registered under Sections 323, 354 and 506 IPC, at Police Station Cantt. Jalandhar, and all the subsequent proceeding arising therefrom on the basis of compromise with a further prayer for quashing the order dated 24.2.2021 passed by the learned JMIC, Jalandhar, whereby the petitioners have been declared proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition at this stage with liberty to approach the Court of competent jurisdiction for the redressal of their claim.

Allowed to do so with liberty as prayed for.

In case, the petitioners surrender and file an appropriate application before the Court concerned within 7 days from today, they would have protection from arrest for 7 days from the date of filing of the application which will be decided by the Court of competent jurisdiction in accordance with law.
