The petitioner is aggrieved because respondent No.4 has been appointed as Chowkidar. Appeal filed by him has failed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the Courts below were in error in appointing respondent No.4 as the Chowkidar. The Sub-Divisional Magistrate has committed a patent illegality by not examining the merits of the petitioner while appointing respondent No.4 as the Chowkidar. The order was thus, perverse and the appellate Court should have interfered therewith.

A perusal of the order of the Sub-Divisional Magistrate dated 13.06.2019 shows that the argument is factually incorrect. The merits of the petitioner have been taken into consideration while appointing respondent No.4 as the Chowkidar. Thus, no interference is called for.

The writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
