Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for seeking aside the orders dated 31.01.2022 (Annexure P-5) and 10.05.2022 (Annexure P-6), whereby the Appellate Court has cancelled the bail, forfeited the bail/surety bonds to the State and issued non-bailable warrants of the petitioner in an appeal titled as Ankit Singh Vs. Dharanveer Saini, wherein order dated 23.08.2021, was passed by the Appellate Court directing the petitioner to deposit 20% amount of compensation awarded by the trial Court within a period of 60 days under Section 148 of NI Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to some unavoidable circumstances the petitioner was unable to comply with the

aforesaid order dated 23.08.2021 and due to same reason the petitioner failed to appear before the Appellate Court on the concerned dates. The counsel further submits that now the petitioner is ready to deposit the amount in compliance of order dated 23.08.2021 in the Appellate Court, However, he is having apprehension that on his appearance the petitioner would arrested.

In view of the above, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the Appellate Court on or before the next date fixed there i.e. 05.08.2022 and to deposit the amount in question, in compliance of order dated 23.08.2021. On his doing so, the trial Court is directed to release him on bail, on his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to its own satisfaction.
