This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for setting aside the order dated 31.05.2022 and 10.05.2022 (Annexures P-5 and P-6, respectively) whereby while cancelling the bail, the bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner were ordered to be forfeited and non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued.

Learned counsel submits that against the judgment of conviction dated 23.07.2021 and order of sentence dated 26.07.2021 petitioner preferred an appeal and while suspending the sentence of the petitioner, a condition of depositing 20% of the cheque amount was also imposed upon him by the appellate Court vide decision dated 23.08.2021 (Annexure P-2). He states that as the needful was not done, the appellate Court proceeded to cancel his bail vide order dated 31.01.2022 and now the case is fixed for 05.08.2022. Learned counsel

further states that the petitioner would comply with the order dated 23.08.2021 and would deposit the requisite amount on 30.05.2022.

In case, the petitioner appears before the appellate Court on 30.05.2022 and tenders the amount as directed by appellate Court vide order dated 23.08.2021, he be released on bail subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds and the appellate Court may recall the warrants issued against him.
