The petitioner has approached this Court seeking writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* so as to recover the alleged detainee Parveen Begum, aged about 24 years.

Learned State counsel has today passed on a statement of Parveen Begum recorded in terms of the provisions of Section 164 Cr.P.C. to the effect that she is residing with her parents out of her own accord and free Will and wishes to reside with her parents. A photocopy of the said statement is taken on record.

In view of the aforestated position, it transpires that the alleged detainee is not illegally detained. As such, no further direction is required to be issued. The petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
