[1] Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 and 13 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order dated 27.04.2021 in CWP No.9085 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) dated 27.04.2021 reveals that while issuing notice of motion in CWP No.9085 of 2021, operation of impugned order dated 30.03.2021 was stayed and on account of failure of the respondents to comply with orders dated 27.04.2021 in CWP No.9085 of 2021, the instant petition was filed.

[3] However, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners on instructions from the arguing counsel states that the main writ petition has been decided in favour of the petitioners on 20.12.2021 and the respondents have complied with the final judgment of the High Court in CWP No.9085 of 2021, therefore, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be disposed of

[4] In view of the position noted above, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondents.

[5] Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of, as such.
