ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)

The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 16 dated 16.01.2021, registered under Section 379-A IPC at Police Station Urban Estate, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR was registered at the instance of one Naresh Kumar with the allegations that when he was going back to his house, two unknown persons came on a motorcycle and snatched his mobile phone. It was further stated that he can identify the accused person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that later on, the police arrested one Sumit Kumar and on his disclosure, the name of the petitioner surfaced in the present case.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is a young man, aged about 21 years; he is not involved in any other case; he is working as a carpenter with his father and has falsely been implicated in this

case.

Learned counsel further submits that there is a delay of two days in lodging the FIR.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Deepak Kumar Grewal, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdish Kumar, has not disputed the factual position but opposed the bail.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without making any comment on the merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions of learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted the concession of anticipatory bail, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it will be open for the Investigating Officer to call upon the petitioner to join investigation, if so required, by issuing him a written notice in this regard.
