The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct the respondents to update the Computer System and include “Darzi” Caste as Bakward Caste in their Computer System and further to issue Backward Caste Certificate.

Learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab has handed over today in Court letter No. DGR.PSeGOSEWA/6/2021-Technical DGR/e-148229/5685-5686 dated 07.11.2022. As per which the caste of Darzi has already been entered in the E-Sewa Software for Backward Caste.

In view of the above, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not press the instant petition and seeks withdrawal of the same in order to approach the competent authority for

issuance of Backward Caste certificate
