Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of a direction to official respondents No.1 to 3 to take action by lodging an FIR against private respondent No.4.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that on 11.04.2022, when the petitioner was returning home, respondent No.4, who was accompanied by a person in his car, started teasing her, used obscene language and tried to touch her. She submits that a representation dated 18.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) has been submitted with the police regarding the incident, but no action has been taken thereon. Counsel requests that the representation may kindly be directed to look into.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. A.S.Gill, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on their behalf.

Having considered the matter, but without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation (Annexure P-1), petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna, Police District Khanna, respondent No.2 to examine the representation (Annexure P-1) and take a suitable action thereon as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the petition be supplied to the State Counsel during course of the day.
