Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 243 dated 06.07.2007, registered under Sections 420 and 34 IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar.

Vide order dated 12.08.2021 passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.
