This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 142 dated 22.12.2016 registered under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Muktsar Sahib (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise.

On a pointed query raised, learned counsel for the petitioner, very fairly, has submitted that respondent No. 4 is the wife of the deceased and she has not signed the compromise deed and thus, on account of the same, he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after entering into the compromise with all the LRs of the deceased.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

It is made clear that in case if the fresh petition would be filed, the same would be considered independently on its merits, in accordance with law.
