VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 4482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of DDR no.36 dated 01.08.2021 registered under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Cantt. Jalandhar, i.e. the cross version recorded in FIR no.87 dated 01.08.2021 registered under Sections 323, 324, 354, 34 IPC (Section 354 IPC deleted later on) at Police Station Cantt. Jalandhar, police Commissionerate, Jalandhar and all consequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, after arguing for some time, seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take up all the points which have been raised in the present petition, during the course of trial at the appropriate stage.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has prayed that petitioner no.1 is a law student at KCL Institution of Law, Jalandhar and petitioner

no.2 is a house wife and has thus, prayed that the personal appearance of the petitioners no.1 and 2 may be exempted before the trial Court. Learned counsel for the petitioners has further submitted that petitioners no.1 and 2 would comply with all the orders passed by the trial Court subject to legal remedies available with petitioners no.1 and 2.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

In the meantime, the personal appearance of petitioner nos.1 and 2 before the trial Court is exempted, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) Petitioner nos.1 and 2 shall be represented through their counsel;*
- ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;*
- iii) shall not dispute their identity as accused;*
- iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in their absence but in the presence of their counsel;*
- v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court;*
- vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.*
